with a **FREE BOOK** from the Auburn Public Library!

Ages 0-12 / Log Your Reading!

- 1 Register for the Summer Reading Program | Choose your FREE BOOK!
- 2 Receive your registration packet
- 3 Record all reading minutes on the reading log
- 4 Turn in your reading log at least once a week if you can! Turn them in as often as you like, anytime during our hours of operation! Receive additional beads, brag tags, and sometimes a surprise!

What counts as reading? Everything!

Your child can read, aloud or silently, to him or herself, to a sibling, pet, stuffed animal, friend, parents, grandparents, etc.

If your child peruses a book and makes up his or her own story, reads silently, views the pictures silently or tells the story out loud, reads the back of a cereal box, attends a program at the library, reads a stop sign – **everything counts!**

*Encourage reading by having books in every room!
Swap them out (as well as keep the favorites)!*

Earn Reading Points | Ages 3 and older

- 1 Earn one bead for each **5 minutes** of reading
- 2 Earn a 'star' bead for every **6 beads** you earn
- 3 Earn a new 'brag tag' for every **30 minutes** you read (or 3 specialty beads if you have all the brag tags)
- 4 Earn your choice of a new, **free** book for every **5 hours** you read!
- 5 Earn additional 'surprise reading incentives' throughout your reading journey

Children age 0-3 receive a soft sticker reading log book and stickers **OR** larger beads

Earning reading points follows the same protocol as ages 3 and older

- In order to receive your information packets and reading incentives, registration must take place in the Library.
- You may register your child anytime during the Summer Reading Program, which is from Saturday July 10th – Saturday August 7th 2021.
