Thursday 4/19	10:00	Birds' Nests	Learn how and why birds build their nests. Create a bird's nest!	3-8
	11:00	Weaving	Learn how other cultures use basket weaving as an art form and as a way of earning a living. Weave and decorate your own basket.	4-12
	12:00	Alphabet	Listen and engage with the story Chicka Chicka Boom Boom . Bedazzle or decorate the letters to your name and take them home in a box you can also decorate. (*children must listen to the story before making the craft).	2-8
	1:00	Construction and trucks	Discuss trucks and construction of buildings and moving earth. Construct one or several trucks to take home!	4-8
	2:00	Scavenger Hunt	Join a literacy based scavenger hunt. Two hunts, with prizes: One for younger children; one for older children.	2-6 and 7-12
